Monitoring Activities

- Monitoring schedule for the year is in progress. Districts who are doing self-monitoring are in two timeframes. The first timeframe is October 7 – November 1, 2019. Onsite monitoring calendars are still in progress. The second timeframe is January 13 -February 7, 2020.
- Districts who had inappropriate policies, procedures, or practices according the APR Self-Assessment were issued Compliance Action Plans (CAP).
- Districts who are identified as having Significant Disproportionality and who must set aside 15% of their 2020-2021 budget have been notified.

Program Effectiveness

- State Education Advisors are scheduling visits to districts to see district special education programs and highlights.
- The Administrator for Monitoring and Program Effectiveness is one of the trainers for the No Limits! Inclusion training this spring/summer.
- Two State Education Advisors are scheduled to attend the LRP Legal Conference in May 2020.
- The Administrator for Monitoring and Program Effectiveness is scheduled to attend the IDEA Data Center Interactive Institute in March 2020.
