COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION ISSUES

C-19-19

- **1.** That the District failed to implement the Student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) in the area of provision of a paraprofessional. (S)
- 2. That the District failed to implement the Student's IEP in the area of provision of IEP Services while the student was in In-School-Suspension. (NS)

C-19-22

- 1. That the District failed to develop and implement an appropriate IEP in the areas of appropriate, measurable goals and provision of pragmatics. (S)
- 2. That the District failed to provide a copy of the IEP to the Complainant. (S)

C-19-24

- 1. That the District failed to notify the parent before discontinuing annual goals and objectives. (S)
- 2. That the District failed to provide a free appropriate public education to the Student by failing to provide progress reports. (NS)

C-19-25

- 1. That the District failed to ensure an IEP be developed and implemented for the Student with a disability, specifically by not ensuring programming as written in the Student's IEP. (S)
- 2. That the District failed to ensure that the IEP team review the Student's IEP periodically, but not less than annually, to determine whether the annual goals for the Student are being achieved. (S)
- That the District failed to revise the IEP as appropriate to address any lack of expected progress toward the annual goals and in the general education curriculum. (S)

C-19-26

 That the District failed to implement Child Find requirements, specifically by not gathering relevant functional and developmental information such as assessing in all areas related to the suspected disability. Including but not limited to social and emotional status. (S)

C-19-27

- 1. That the District failed to develop and implement an IEP for the Student that is reasonably calculated to allow for meaningful progress, specifically by:
 - A. not conducting a Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA) and developing and implementing a Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP) to address the Student's behavioral needs. (S)
 - B. not addressing the Student's mental health needs and not providing mental health therapy; and (S)
 - C. not providing services during change of placement; (S)
- That the District failed to evaluate the Student in all areas of suspected disability.
- 3. That the District failed to ensure necessary IEP team members were present to develop an IEP that allowed for creation of an IEP that is reasonably calculated to address the Student's needs, specifically by not inviting a mental health professional; and (S)

4.	that the District failed to allow for parent participation in developing the IEP, specifically by not providing training to the parent on the Google platform used for accessing the Student's assignments. (NS)
