# **Meeting Proceedings**

### Call to Order:

The meeting began at 9:00 a.m., led by Mr. Dewey Graves, Co-chairperson. Mr. Graves welcomed all Advisory Council members and Division of Elementary and Secondary Education, Office of Special Education (DESE-OSE) staff.

## **Presentation on Special Education Annual Performance Report (APR):**

Dr. Jody Fields, Special Education Data Manager, along with other OSE staff and consultants, presented the FFY 2023 Special Education APR results in alignment with the State Performance Plan (SPP) targets. The presentation followed a student's educational journey, covering:

- Early Childhood Indicators: Preschool Transition (Indicator 12), Child Find (Indicator 11), Preschool Educational Environments (Indicator 6), Preschool Outcomes (Indicator 7), Family Involvement (Indicator 8).
- **School Age Indicators:** School Age Educational Environment (Indicator 5 Disproportionality (Indicators 9 & 10), Discipline (Indicator 4).
- Academic Progress and Outcomes: Assessment (Indicator 3), State Systemic Improvement Plan (Indicator 17), Secondary Transition (Indicator 13), Graduation (Indicator 1), Dropout (Indicator 2), Post-School Outcomes (Indicator 14).
- Other Compliance Indicators: Resolution Session (Indicator 15), Mediation (Indicator 16), General Supervision (Indicator 18).

The Council asked several clarifying questions to Dr. Fields on the data.

## Presentation on Arkansas Special Education Teacher Registered Apprenticeship:

Ms. Lisa Tyler, State Apprenticeship Specialist for Educator Effectiveness and Licensure, discussed the new Arkansas Special Education Teacher Registered Apprenticeship. This initiative, under the Arkansas Grow Your Own program, provides a pathway to teacher licensure through a financially accessible, hands-on approach. Aspiring educators gain classroom experience, earn a salary, and obtain licensure while remaining in their communities without additional financial burden.
