- 2. that the District failed to consider the outside evaluation provided by the Parent [9.03.3.1], (NS)
- that the District failed to allow for meaningful parent participation, specifically, limiting the Parent's ability to get and receive information about the Student's educational program §34 CFR 300.613.(NS)
- 4. that the District denied a Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) by not allowing the Student to return to school after morning appointments [5.01.1]. (NS)
