Due Process Complaint Investigation: The SEAs assist Dispute Resolution with conducting on-site district level complaint investigations.

LEA Regional Team Meetings: SEAs attend these meeting to facilitate communication and to provide support to local LEAs. Information from ADE is shared with LEAs. Additionally, questions, comments and concerns shared by LEAs are then brought back to ADE-SEU.

ADE-School Improvement/ADE-SEU Collaboration (Priority and Focus Schools)

SEA/District support and collaboration: Districts with corrective action plans (CAPs) receive ongoing support and technical assistance through the monitoring section. SEAs schedule frequent check-ins with these districts, assisting and supporting each district throughout the process.

Cycle 4 Monitoring 2016-2017 School Year:

67 special education programs are scheduled to be monitored during the 2016-2017 school year. ADE-SEU utilized a "Risk Checklist" to determine level of monitoring needs within all 67 programs. Based on the risk factors established, some districts will do self-monitoring only, some districts will be asked to submit additional evidence, and some districts will receive an onsite visit.
