

Arkansas' Indicator 14: Post-School Outcomes

6-Year Sampling Plan for 2026-2031

Post-school outcomes are collected through a stratified random sample. Stratified random sampling without replacement assigns each LEA to a sampling year. The Local Education Agencies' (LEA) Average Daily Membership (ADM) strata are based on 2024-25 data. The strata are assigned according to natural splits in the existing ADM data. Within these strata, LEAs were randomly assigned to a collection year. The Springdale School District, Bentonville School District, and Little Rock School District are the three largest LEAs in Arkansas and have an ADM of over 19,000 but under 30,000; therefore, they are the only LEAs within ADM strata A. These three LEAs will be sampled twice in the six-year period, while all other districts will be sampled once in the six-year period. Summaries of the number of districts within each stratum and per year are provided in Tables 1 and 2.

The sampling plan is a sample of districts, not students. In 2005, when Indicator 14 was put in place, the Arkansas Department of Education's leadership determined that the collection would put an undue burden on the LEAs. So, a sampling of LEAs was selected with a census of special education students exiting the LEAs who met the criteria using a contractor.

As for selection bias, the sampling of LEAs allows the collected data to represent the state. Arkansas' population varies greatly. One can draw a line from the northeast to the southwest corner, and the population on each side of the line differs. Fifty-seven percent of students in Arkansas are white; however, there is a growing Hispanic population in the western half of the state, while the central and eastern half have a higher black population. Every sampling year includes LEAs from the state's various regions, thus providing a representative picture of the state.

The census of students from the sampled LEAs who exited special education and meet the criteria exit reasons comprise the list of students for which data are collected. Over the six-year plan, approximately 45 LEAs will be sampled each year, with the number of students being contacted averaging 600. Special education exit reasons include Graduated with a Diploma, Graduated with a Certificate, Reached Maximum Age, and Dropped Out. In the 2022-2023 school year, Arkansas had its first set of graduates under the Alternate Pathway to Graduation (1% assessment students). This new exit reason was included when selecting students.

Additionally, the ADM strata and random assignment are adjusted accordingly for the addition or closure of districts, including charter schools. The number of Charter schools in the State fluctuates from year to year, and while many do not include high schools, they are gradually adding new grade levels to their existing buildings. The Charter schools are included in the sampling methodology to ensure their changing enrollment is captured.

Data Collection: Arkansas conducts a dual data collection: phone survey and administrative data mine. A private company conducts phone surveys. The administrative data mining includes data from the Arkansas Division of Higher Education, the Division of Workforce Services, Arkansas Rehabilitation Services, and Adult Education. Arkansas will continue to explore other opportunities to partner with other state agencies

to improve the data mining process. Expanding the number of agencies participating in the collection should improve the representativeness. The DESE OSE has established data-sharing agreements for data collection with the agencies mentioned above.

The post-school outcomes data set is compiled based on the 618-exiting data. The data set includes former students who the LEA exited from special education for the following reasons: Graduated with a Diploma, Graduated with a Certificate, Reached Maximum Age, or Dropped Out. Graduates on the alternate pathway were initially added in the 2022-23 school year.

For more than 10 years, Arkansas has used dual data collection, which allows us to locate more students than a phone or mail survey. This helps address non-response bias because we can locate information for exited students that may not be located with a single methodology. Further since the collection is based on the sampled LEAs with a census of students who exited with specific reasons, there is not a way to oversample to improve response or representative rates for a given year.

The data sharing agreement (DSA) for the contractor conducting the phone interviews does not include PII data; it only includes directory data, such as names and phone numbers from the student management system. The DSAs with state agencies include PII information to ensure accurate matching to the special education exit data. Data received from the partnered agencies are destroyed once matched to the existing data and provided to the Office of Special Education for Indicator 14 analysis.

Treatment of Missing Data: The survey response rate is examined and reported. In addition, missing data is evaluated. Subsequently, a sensitivity analysis is conducted to investigate the effects, if any, of non-response and missing data on the survey results. Demographic and historical data are evaluated regarding differences between students who respond and those who do not. Estimates and analysis are adjusted accordingly.

Representativeness Analysis: A \pm of 3.00 percentage points is used to determine a discrepancy in the demographics over- or under-representation in the sampled LEAs (target group). Arkansas analyzes the PSO data for representativeness in race/ethnicity, disability category, and exit reason.
